The issues of Human Rights are of utmost importance in the present society. The UN Decade for Human Rights Education (1995-2004) defined Human Rights Education, "a lifelong process by which people at all levels of development and in all strata of society learn respect for the dignity of others and the means and methods of ensuring that respect in all societies." Thus imparting knowledge on Human Rights Education will teach all to respect the dignity of each other and to promote a healthy, cooperative and peaceful life in society. It is also the duty of the government to recognize the claims of the people; their exclusive and inalienable rights. Thus the true essence of democratic society lies with the recognition of these human rights as universal rights. Human Rights Education is a subject that aims to protect, promote and popularize the concept of Human Rights among all sections of society.
