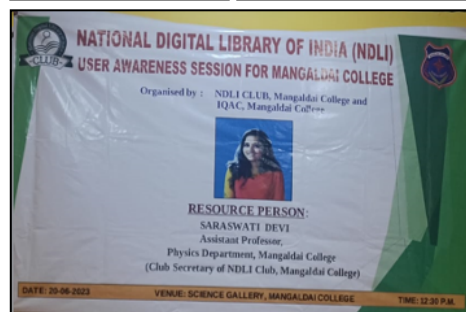
2. SWAYAM-NPTEL Local Chapter, Mangaldai College:

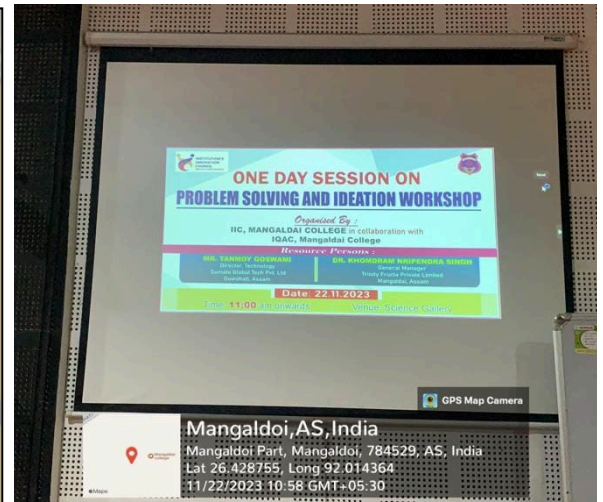
11. Yuva Tourism Club:

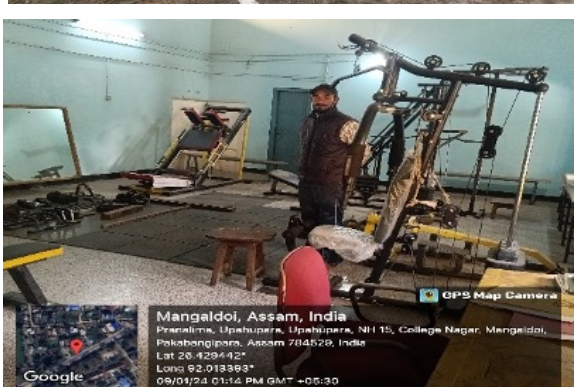
13. Institutional Biotech Hub:

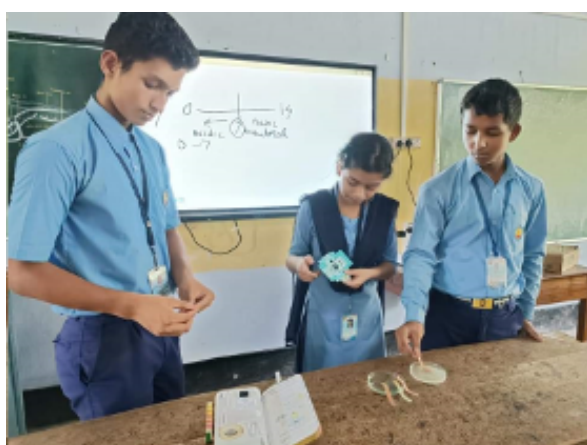
14. Fostering Sports Facilities to the community:
