The IQAC, Mangaldai College in collaboration with Darrang District Administration has organised a three month coaching for aspirants of UPSC/APSC/SSC and other competitive examinations. The inauguration ceremony was held on 6th August 2022 in the Science Gallery. The program started at 1 pm with the welcome address by Dr. Kamala Kanta Borah, Principal, Mangaldai College. The ceremony was graced by Mr. Pranab Kr. Sarma, Deputy Commissioner, Darrang and several other officials from Darrang district administration. Around 102 participants comprising of faculties and retired faculties of Mangaldai College and many distinguished persons from Mangaldai took part in the event. Students from different parts of Darrang District took active part in this programme.

Awareness Meeting on Tobacco Burden & Training on COPTA-2003

An awareness meeting on Tobacco Burden and Training on COPTA-2003 was organised by District Health Society, Darrang, District Tobacco Control Cell in collaboration with IQAC, Mangaldai College on 9th September 2022 at the Science Gallery of Mangaldai College. Dr. Harpal Singh Suri, Joint Director of Health Services, Darrang delivered the inaugural speech. The resource persons - Arzoo Dutta, Senior Consultant National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP), Assam and Dr N K Beriya, District Nodal Officer, DHS-NTCP, Darrang stressed the need to maintain a tobacco free environment in the campuses and surroundings of educational institutions and also to make society aware of the serious health hazards of tobacco consumption. Dr Shahidul Islam of Darrang Cancer Hospital in his lecture narrated that the use of any form of tobacco happens to be one of the prime cause of oral cancer. Resource person Priyanka Kakati, Regional Coordinator, the International Union, spoke about the tobacco monitoring app COPTA-2003 that can be used to lodge complaints if anyone is found consuming tobacco within 100 yards of any public institution. In this event, Mangaldai College was declared a 'Tobacco-Free Educational Institution' and a certificate was handed over to the college authority. Around 192 participants comprising of faculty members and students of Mangaldai College took part in the program.











Interdepartmental Academic Exchange Program

On 12th October 2022, an inaugural session of Inter Departmental Academic Exchange Program under NEP 2020 was held at Mangaldai College. The program was inaugurated by Dr K.K Borah, Principal of Mangaldai College. The 30th District level NCSC project presentation was held in Mangaldai College on 20th November 2022. More than 200 students from almost 18 schools participated in the event from different areas of Darrang district with a total 70 Science projects. The event was coordinated by District Coordinator, NCSC Dr. Kangkan Sarmah, Assistant professor, Department of Physics, Mangaldai College. The event was a showcase of creativity and innovativeness by the students. The models mainly focussed on exhibited societal problems experienced locally and finding their solutions using scientific methods by the school children.

Seven projects from upper age group and one project from lower age group got selected to represent Darrang District at the 30th State-Level National Children's Science Congress that was held at Tezpur Govt. Boys Higher Secondary School from 16th of Dec to 19th of Dec 2022 where a total of 271 students from different parts of Assam presented their Science project.

Book by WSRC










Celebration of 73rd Constitution Day
