

Awareness Programme on Developing Scientific Temperament

A public awareness meeting on developing scientific temperament was organised by Women Study and Research Cell (WSRC) on 24th December 2019 in association with Assam Science Society, Mangaldai Branch and Crystal Vision NGO in Danhee Higher Secondary School. Resource Person Dr. Kamaleswar Nath, a Medical Practitioner explained about the difference among common belief, disbelief and superstition prevailing in the society and ways to eradicate by developing scientific temperament among the people.
