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TEACHER TRAINING & FACULTY DEVELOPMENT POLICY
(As per AICTE Guidelines)

1. Introduction:

Mangaldai College (Autonomous) recognizes that continuous professional development of teachers is essential for maintaining academic excellence and quality education. In accordance with the guidelines of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the institution has formulated a Teacher Training Policy to enhance the teaching, research, and professional competencies of faculty members.

3.2 Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs)

- Faculty members are encouraged to participate in:
- AICTE-approved FDPs
- Refresher and Orientation Programmes
- Workshops, seminars, and conferences
- At least one FDP per academic year is encouraged for every faculty member.

3.3 Digital & Pedagogical Training

- Regular training on:
- Learning Management Systems (LMS)
- Online teaching tools
- ICT-enabled teaching
- Outcome-Based Education (OBE)
- Emphasis on innovative teaching and assessment methods.

3.4 Research & Publication

- Faculty members are encouraged to:
- Publish research papers in reputed journals
- Present papers in national and international conferences
- Participate in research projects and collaborations

4. Implementation of the Policy

- ✓ The College Academic Committee shall oversee the implementation of the policy.
- ✓ A Faculty Development Coordinator shall be appointed to:
- ✓ Maintain training records
- ✓ Monitor participation
- ✓ Prepare annual training reports

Necessary financial and administrative support shall be provided by the institution.

5. Monitoring and Review

- ✓ Faculty performance will be reviewed annually based on:
- ✓ Participation in training programs
- ✓ Academic contribution
- ✓ Teaching effectiveness
- ✓ Feedback from students and stakeholders will be considered.

The policy shall be reviewed periodically to align with AICTE norms and institutional requirements.
